

Magic Lincer Tennis Club of Manchester and Magic Lincer Tennis Academy Safety Plan for Return to Tennis with COVID-19

Because tennis does not require any direct person-to-person contact, players can enjoy the many physical and mental benefits that tennis offers as you practice social distancing to ensure you are in a safe exercise environment and follow other safety recommendations included here. Fully vaccinated individuals are not required to wear masks in our facilities. Players whom are not vaccinated will need to wear their mask in the lobby and on the court unless playing singles or getting a private lesson.

PROVIDE A CLEAN ENVIRONMENT

- All staff have chosen to be fully vaccinated.
- We clean all surfaces—such as counters, tabletops, doorknobs, bathroom fixtures and toilets—several times a day.
- Disinfectant soap, hand sanitizers and wipes will be readily available.

ENCOURAGE PHYSICAL DISTANCING

- People should stay at least six feet apart to maintain physical distancing.
- Players should maintain physical distancing if changing ends of the court.
- We minimize contact between participants and staff.
- We recommend that only one parent/guardian accompany younger children to the facility when possible. Parents should wait in the parking lot.
- Promote prevention techniques and lead by example.

• COACHING

- Group coaching will be limited to four players as usual for our club.
- Players will be kept a safe distance apart on the court.
- Unvaccinated players will be required to wear masks in group lessons but not in private lessons.
